A collaboration with the youth organization **STAN**.

The art object and participation tool "The Rolling Table" (<u>Club Real</u>, Berlin) travels through the public space of Bern and Biel and invites to an exchange on the question: what does it take for a peaceful coexistence in a diverse society and how do we talk about peace?

Through the movement in public space, as many people as possible with different backgrounds and origins are to be included in the dialogue. Table guests and cards with terms or pictures of current developments and social challenges will initiate the discussion. The dialogue is accompanied jointly by the youth organization STAN and the Polit-Forum Bern. The languages are mixed and range from German and French to English and Ukrainian.

The table rides and discussions will be accompanied by 3 illustrators with different backgrounds: <u>Perla Ciommi</u>, <u>Amélie Cochet</u> and <u>Masha Vyshedska</u>. The results will be presented in an exhibition at the Polit-Forum Bern in September 2022.
